Family and domestic violence is about control and abuse. It is when ones partner or family member behaves in a way that causes the victim to live in fear.

Types of family and domestic violence.

Most people think that family and domestic violence only involves physician abuse, however there are a wide range of abusive behaviours a perpetrator can display. These can include:

- Verbal abuse;
- Social isolation;
- Financial control;
- Psychological abuse;
- Sexual abuse;
- Denying spiritual/ cultural connections.

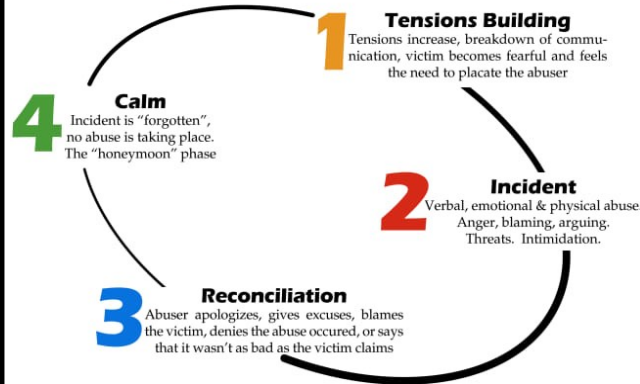
Domestic Violence Advocacy and Victim Support Service (Karratha)

The Domestic Violence Advocacy and Victim Support Service is available to all women who are experiencing family and/or domestic violence. The service provides information, support, referrals and assistance in a secure, confidential setting where clients are safe to tell their story.

The service acts as an important tool to help overcome the trauma, recover and rebuild of life after abuse. Our support worker can assist with:

- Crisis intervention and response;
- Advocacy;
- Violence restraining order applications;
- Court support/ legal advice from our solicitors;
- Housing and emergency accommodation;
- Information and referrals to other community and support services.

Keeping Women Safe in their Homes (South Hedland)

Keeping women safe program (KWS) is an early intervention and prevention strategy aimed to help women and their children from becoming homeless and improve safety following family and domestic violence (FDV). The program helps women to stay in their home or a home of their choosing, when it is safe an appropriate to do so.

Domestic Violence Outreach

The domestic violence outreach (DVO) Service is aimed at breaking the cycle of family and domestic violence. Our domestic violence workers assist with:

- Risk assessment;
- Safety planning;
- Welfare/safety/security checks;
- Linking clients to a wide range of services that address their expressed needs.

The service can provide both practical and emotional support for victims of domestic violence. You do not need to leave the perpetrator to access support.
