What is the Community Migrant Service?

Australia is one of the most diverse populations in the world. Our Community Migrant Service helps migrants not only to adjust to Australian life, but to become vital and active members in the community. The service aims to promote economic and personal wellbeing, self determination, independence, and community connectedness.

The Community Migrant Service is located in Karratha and South Hedland and helps create pathways to learning English, education and employment readiness. The service includes group information sessions, teaching life skills and providing information on areas such as the Australian health system, employment, police and the law and banking practices.

What do our Community Migrant Service team do?

Our Community Migrant Service Team provides one on one casework, support, information and connection to other mainstream services to assist migrants.

Our Community Migrant Service Team also run community development activities that support and empower new community groups. These activities are usually run in-person for groups and individuals.

Migrants new to Australia

We can assist migrants who are new to Australia to:

- apply for housing
- understand letters and documents
- access education (enrol children in school, find English classes, etc)
- access health services
- access centrelink and other government services
- access banking and financial institutions
- access referrals to migration agents and lawyers
- gain recognition of your overseas qualifications
- gain general settlement information
