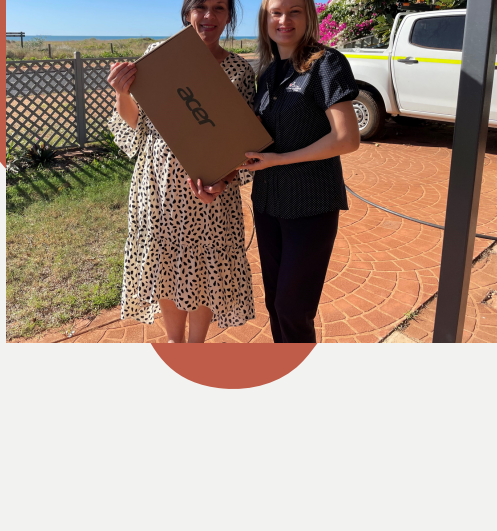




PILBARA COMMUNITY LEGAL SERVICE Inc.

RECONCILIATION WEEK BREAKFAST

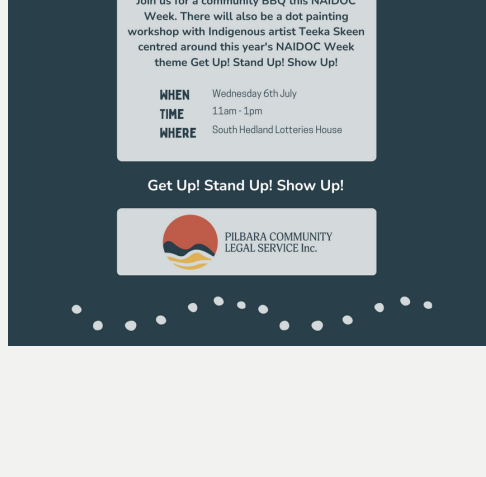

HOUSING SUPPORT



Our Housing Support Workers assist people who are having difficulty sustaining stable accommodation. The program is for people who are at risk of or are experiencing any type of homelessness issues.

COMMUNITY MIGRANT SERVICES

Our Community Migrant Service Workers provide one-on-one casework, support, information and connection to other mainstream services to assist migrants.

LEGAL SUPPORT



Our Legal Team offer free legal advice and assistance in the areas of family law, restraining orders, protection and care, licence disqualifications and extraordinary licences and criminal injuries compensation.

REDRESS SUPPORT

Our Redress Support Workers are here to help survivors of sexual abuse understand the scheme, receive emotional support and guide them through the application process.

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE SUPPORT

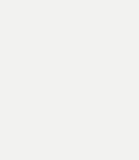

TENANT ADVICE & EDUCATION SERVICE

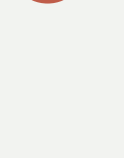
