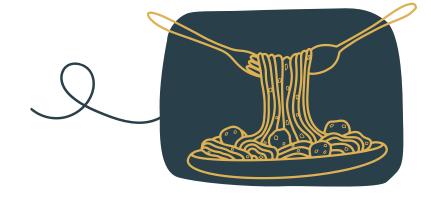


R U OK? DAY
